Delves, Jett and Child elected to serve as Mountain Village Town Council Members

June 30, 2009 (Mountain Village, Colo.) – Incumbents Bob Delves and Cath Jett and newcomer Richard Child were elected (in Delves case, re-elected), to the Mountain Village Town Council today. Child's predecessor is Phil Evans who chose not to run for re-election after serving 10 years on various town boards and Council. Jett was appointed by Council in 2007 after former Council Member Bob Trenary resigned. Town Council members are elected to serve four-year terms with an election every two years. The other 2009 candidates were Brian Ahern, Julie "Meehan" Fee, and David Schillaci.

For the 2009 General Municipal Election, 831 ballots were mailed to registered Mountain Village voters in early June, and 424 electors cast their vote either by mail or in person.

The results are as follows:

- Robert Delves 378
- David "Dave" Schillaci 119
- Catherine "Cath" Jett 337
- Richard Child 140
- Brain Ahern 70
- Julie "Meehan" Fee 77

At Council's July 13th meeting, first on the agenda is the swearing in of Delves, Jett and Child. Next, alongside current Council Members Nick Ball, Dan Garner and Jonathan Greenspan, the Council will appoint two council members, one to serve as mayor and the other to serve as mayor pro-tem. These appointments are done by a majority vote.

Earlier this month, Council Member David Schroeder sold his home in Mountain Village and moved to the town of Telluride; to serve on Mountain Village Town Council, one must be a resident. At the June 9 Town Council meeting, Mayor Bob Delves requested that Schroeder continue his service through the election, and submit his resignation effective July 12. The Council has 45 days, from the date of resignation, to appoint a qualified candidate in his place. Due to time sensitivity, the Council must appoint someone either at its July 13 meeting or wait until the August 20 meeting.
