Telluride Ski & Golf asks the Mountain Village Design Review Board to grant a continuance for its public hearing regarding a proposed outdoor amphitheater.

June 5, 2009 (Mountain Village, Colo.) – Telluride Ski & Golf (TSG) has requested that the Mountain Village Design Review Board (DRB) grant the company a continuance for consideration of a special use permit for the installation of an outdoor summer amphitheater. In a formal letter submitted to the town's Community Development Department, TSG requested that the hearing be continued to the July 9, 2009, DRB meeting. The DRB routinely grants continuances requested by applicants. Through legal obligation, the DRB must address the company's request at their June 11 meeting, but TSG will not present the details of their application at that time.

The purpose of the amphitheater is to serve as a venue for summer concerts and other performing arts, and its proposed location is on Active Open Space Parcel OS-3, otherwise known as the Misty Maiden ski run located at the base of Lift 4.

Since TSG has applied for a special use permit, the DRB will be the first to review the application. They will then make their recommendation of approval or denial to Town Council. Subsequently, Council will review the application and make the final decision. TSG was scheduled to present their application to Council June 25. This special meeting was canceled prior to TSG's request for a continuance.
